APB/WSB Coaches' Certification Course

1. Course Description:

- This course contains:
 - Lecture on AIBA Rules and training principles
 - Practical training and competition simulation
 - This course is to certify the coach to work as a Second in APB and/or WSB Competitions
- The course will be held in Assisi, Italy

2. Course Composition: 7 days as follows

- March 15: Arrival and Registration
- March 16 - 19: Education, Training and Practical Examinations
- March 20: Written and Oral Examination
- March 21: Departure

3. Eligible Applicants:

- Current AIBA Registered Coaches
- Current APB and WSB Coaches

Note: The postponed applicants from the previous APB/WSB course can also apply for this course.

4. Cost:

- The applicants must cover the following costs:
 - Flight, Visa
 - Accommodation (including 3 meals and transportation from/to airport)
 - Double occupancy: 63 EUR per person/night
 - Single occupancy: 78 EUR per person/night
 - Course Fee: USD 300

5. Application Process:

- For current AIBA certified Coaches:
 - Please contact your National Federation to check/register your current coaches status registered in AIBA
